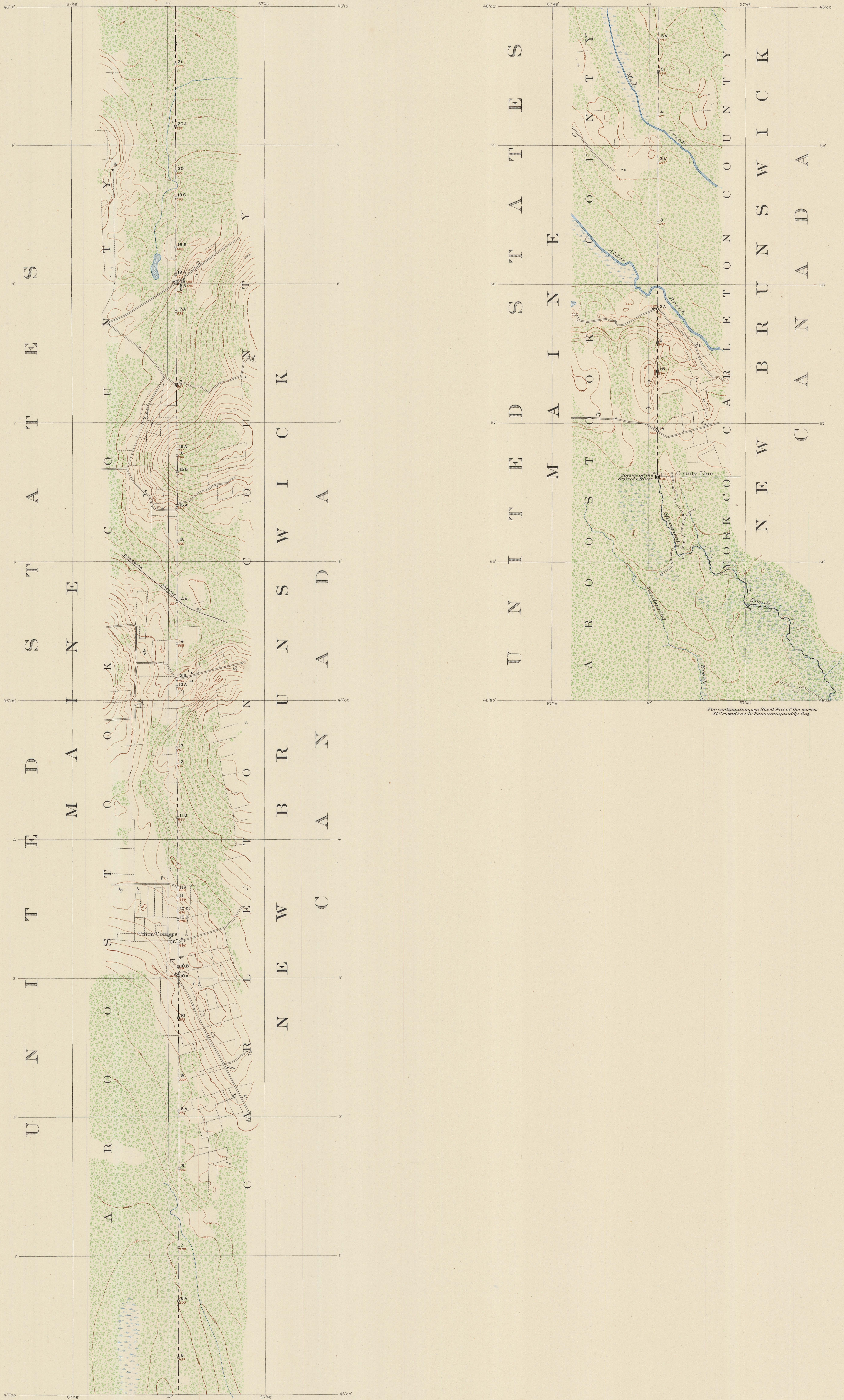


INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY
