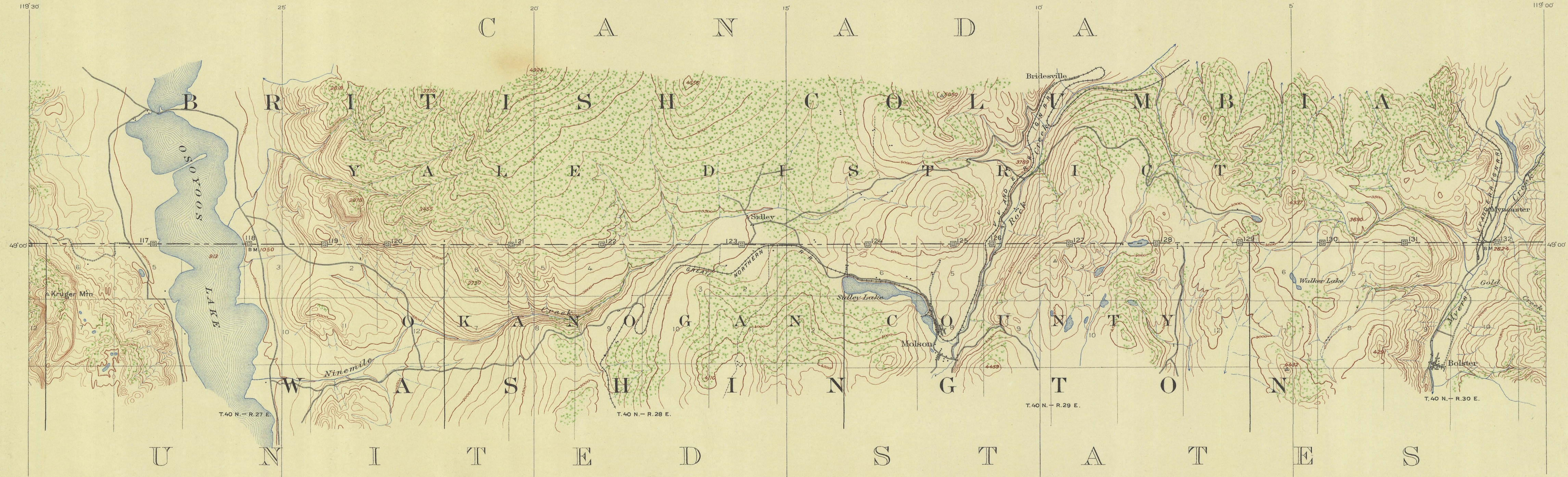


INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY

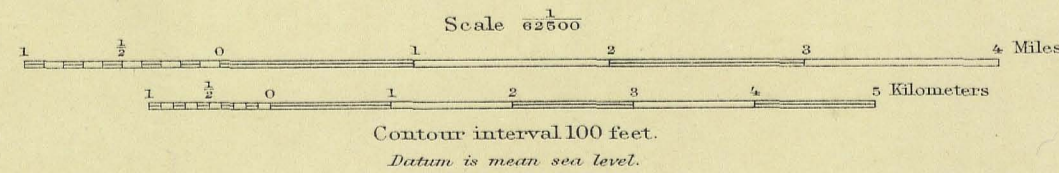
